

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that C.E. Naumann, whose address is 3100 N. 60th Street, Killeen, Texas, being the sole Owner of that certain 7.74 acre tract out of the J.S. Wilder Survey, Abstract No. 913, Killeen, Bell County, Texas, which is fully described in the Dedication of Naumann's Subdivision, do hereby subdivide said land into tracts to be known as Naumann's Subdivision, as shown by the plat hereof, attached hereto, and made a part hereof, and approved by the City Council of the City of Killeen, Bell County, Texas, and C.E. 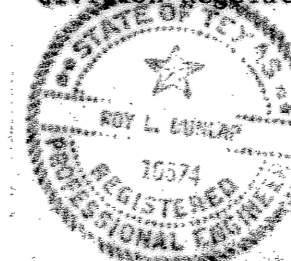
