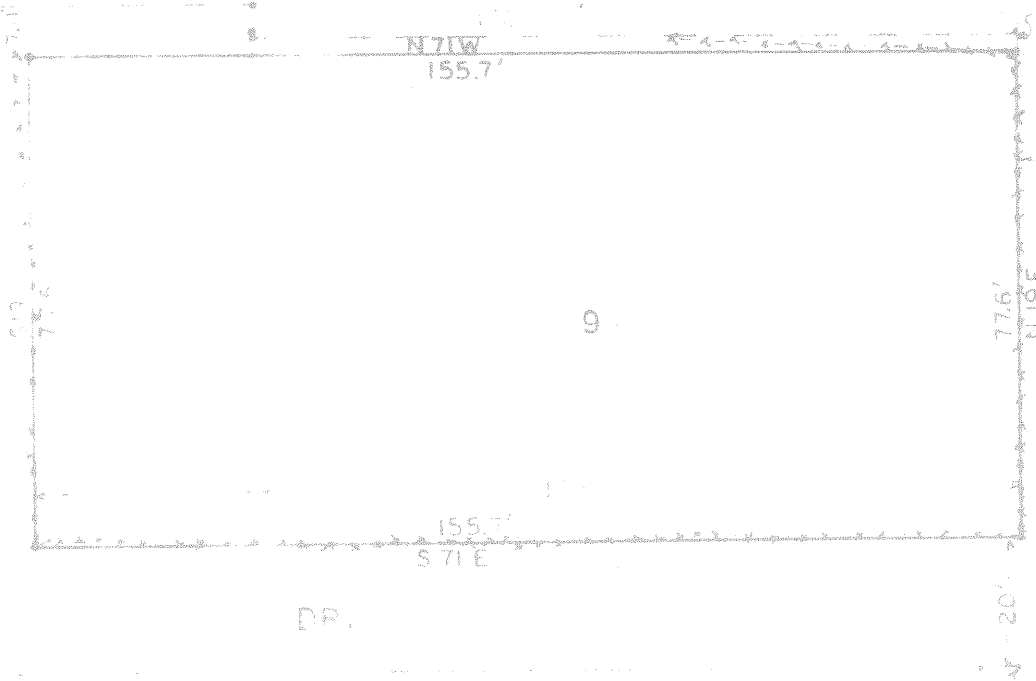

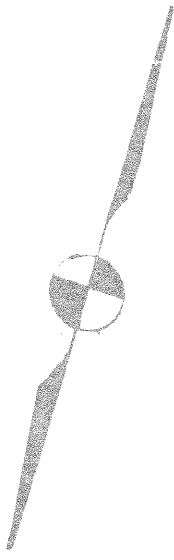
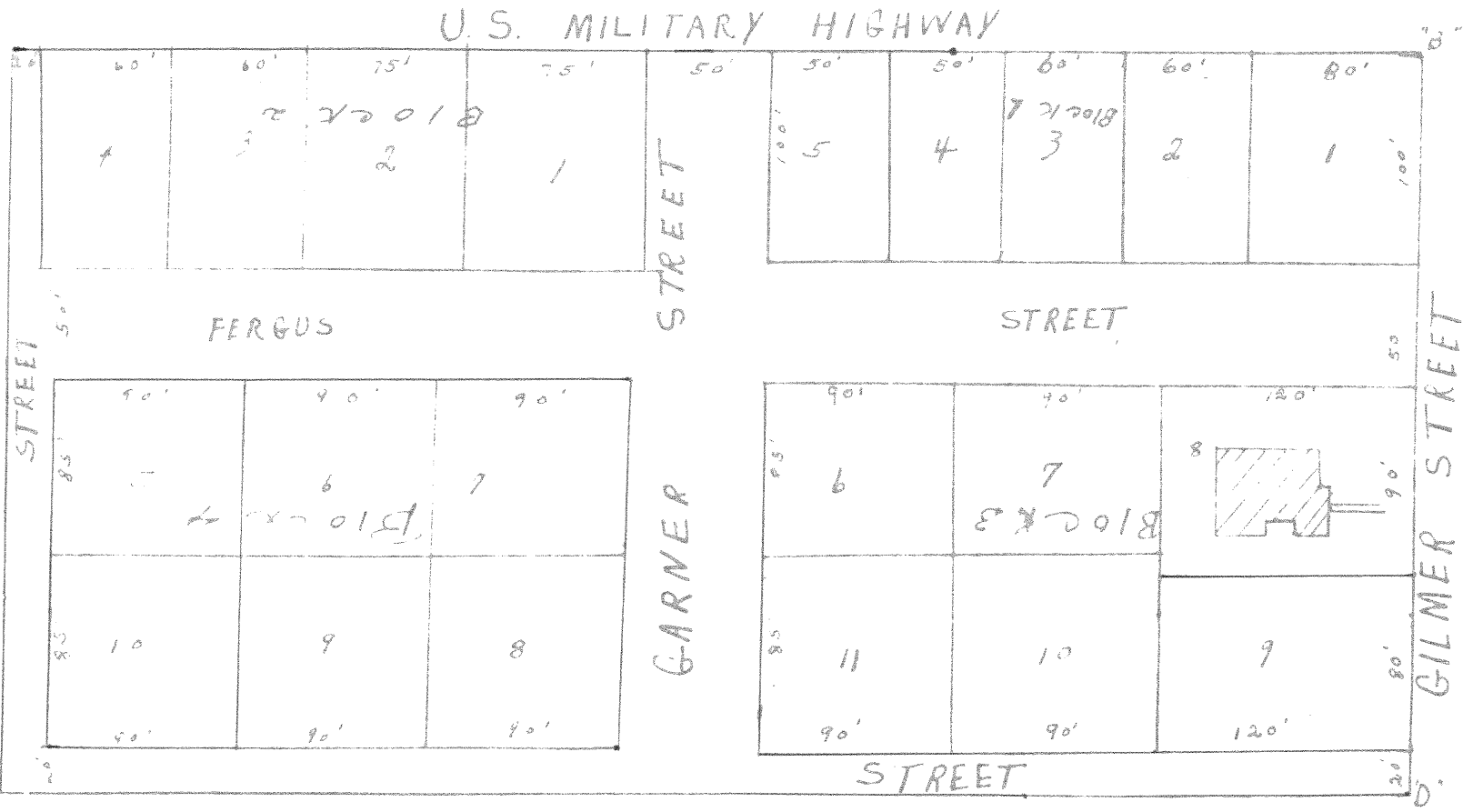

We make no designation outside of corners marked "A" "B" "C" and "D" on this map.

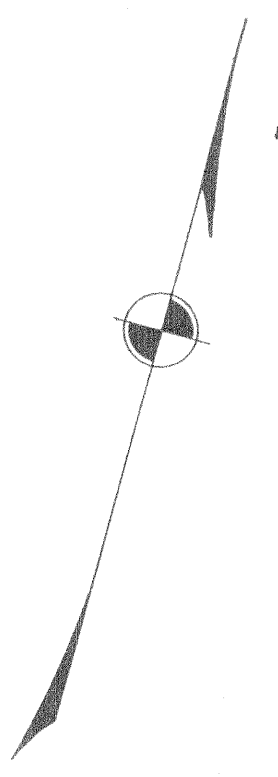
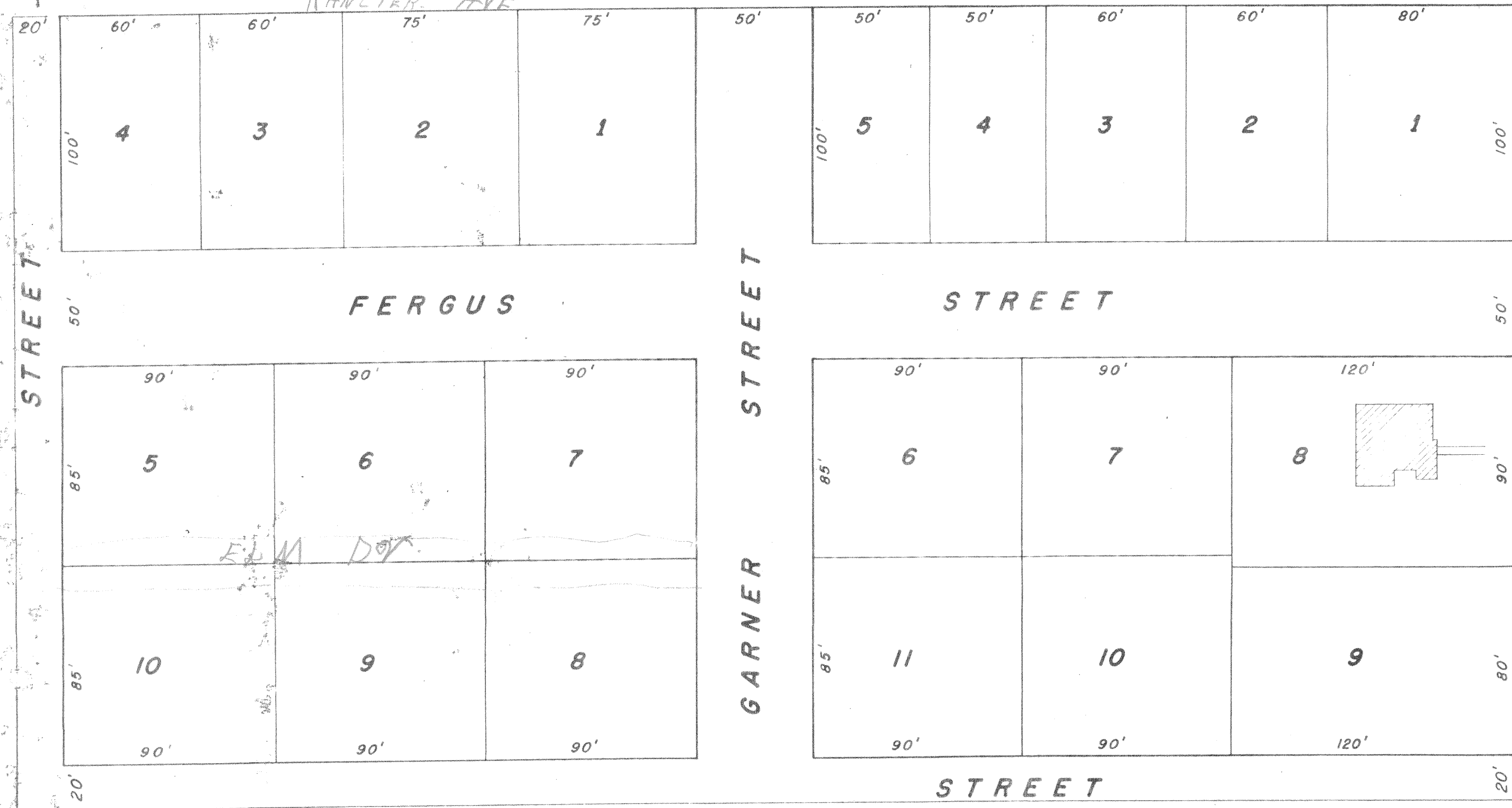
