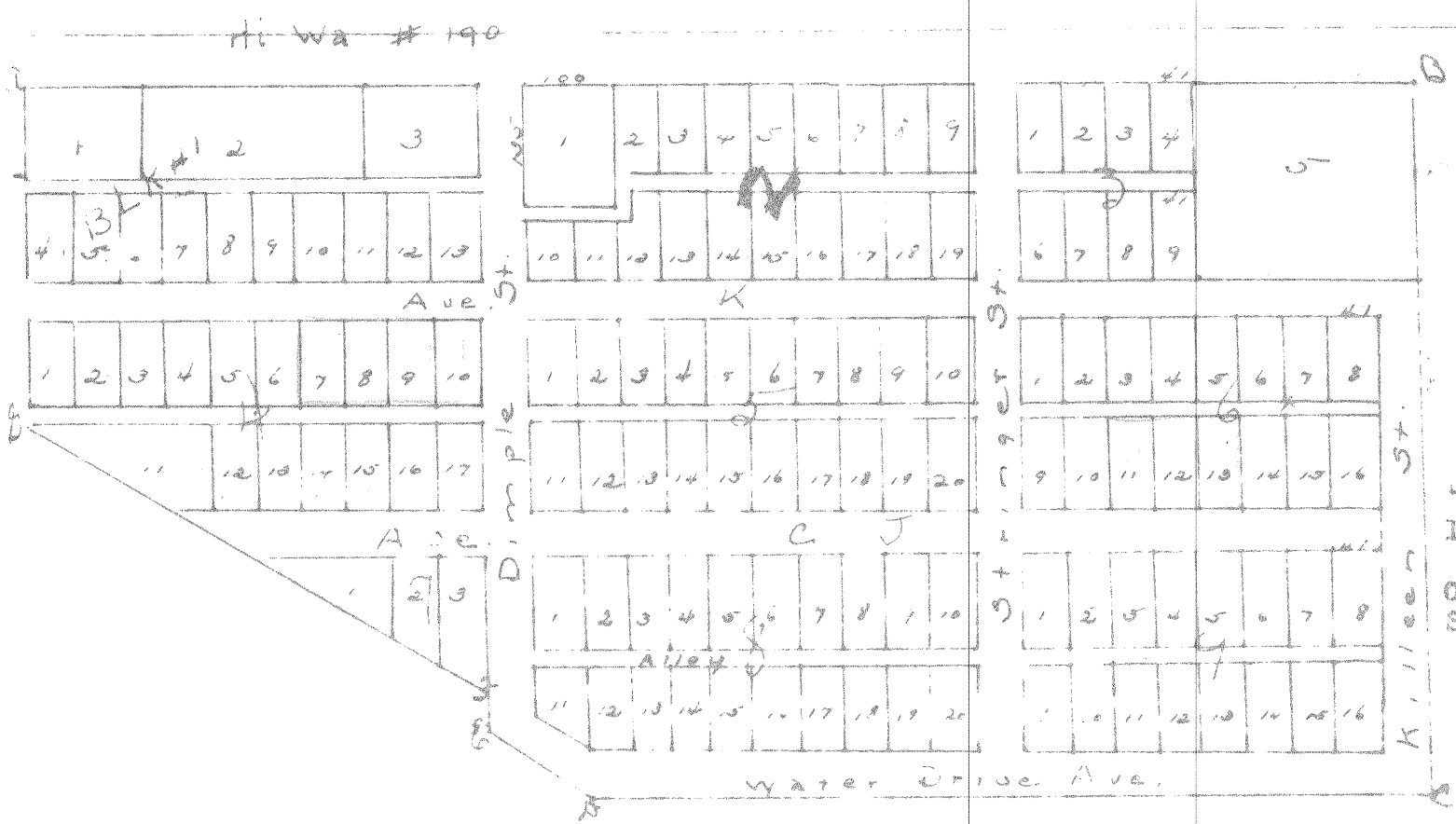


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 Stinger Addition to City of Killeen



Legend

Blocks 1,2,5 are 500' x 214' including 14' alleys. Blocks 6, 9 are 391' x 214' including 14' alleys. Block 8 is 500' x 214' including 14' alley except lot 11 being cut by Avenue K. Block 4 is 500'x214' including 14' alley except lot 11 corner which Nolan Creek bed cuts off. Block 7 is 250' on North side and 175' on east side and being cut into triangular shape from south east corner to north west corner by Nolan Creek. Lots Numbers 1 and 3 of Block 1 are 125'x100' Lot 2 of Block 1 is 250' x 100'. These lots have been deeded by description. Lot 1, Block #2 is 100' x 135'. Lots 10, 11, Block #2, are 50' x 65' and Lot 12, Block #2, has alley way 35' north and south by 14' each and west out out of Northwest corner. Lots #4, 9, Block 3 are 41' x 100' and Lots 8 and 16, Block 6, are 41' x 100', and Lots 8 and 16, Block 9, are 41' x100' Lot #5, Block 3, is 250' x 214'. All other lots are 50' East and west by 100' North and south, all streets are 50' wide and all avenues are 50' wide.
